Subject: Preschool and pre-K back-to-school information

Dear Preschool and Pre-K Families,

As promised in my email on Wednesday, July 29, [which can be read here](#), I am following up with further information specific to our preschool and pre-K classes. The entire team is busily planning for the start of the school year and preparing all the necessary arrangements in order to welcome our preschool and pre-K students to campuses for the first day of school.

Guidelines for LILA Preschool and Pre-K In-Person Return

As you plan your family's in-person return to school, please [read this document carefully](#), which provides an overview of the general guidelines and procedures that LILA will follow for preschool and pre-K classes. Additional campus-specific details regarding drop-off and pickup procedures, schedules, meet and greet opportunities, and more will be forthcoming from your Campus Director.

Remote e-Learning Option for Pre-K

A number of families have reached out to us about the possibility of offering an online option for pre-K, instead of the in-person return model. We are certainly happy to explore the viability of this option with pre-K families. In order for us to make this possible, we would need families to commit to remote e-Learning for the period from August 26 – December 17, which is the last school day in 2020. We could look at this potential offering for both returning pre-K and new pre-K students whose families were not keen for an in-person return. Groups of online classes could be formed with pre-K students from across all our campuses, with the understanding, of course, that an in-person return would take place on the campus/site where the student is enrolled. If numbers warrant the extension of the online option into 2021, we could revisit that closer to the time. We believe we could offer a half-day online equivalent (perhaps with a morning session and an afternoon session), with some flexibility in delivery.
